

PARTNERS GROUP GLOBAL VALUE FUND

Monthly report as of 31 March 2024



Unit price increased by 1.8% in March

- SRS exit valuation at 30% uplift over most recent carrying value
- New secondary investments in Project Portrush 2.0 and Project Toucan Two
- Completed acquisitions of ROSEN Group and Velvet CARE

In March, the unit price of Partners Group Global Value Fund increased by 1.8%, driven by a number of direct private equity portfolio investments, largely within the Fund's 2018-2022 vintages. The largest contributor was SRS Distribution (SRS), one of the largest distributors of roofing, landscaping and pool supply products in the US. As of 31 March 2024, the Fund valued its stake in SRS at a 30% uplift from its most recent valuation, after SRS announced that it has entered into a definitive agreement to be acquired by NYSE-listed, The Home Depot for an enterprise value of USD 18.25 billion. The transaction is still subject to regulatory approvals and other customary closing conditions. According to Pitchbook, the transaction is the fourth-largest private equity exit in the US ever, indicating positive signs for the strategic M&A environment and rebound of transaction activity.

This accretive outcome showcases the attractiveness of the Fund's mature portfolio of high-quality companies, compounding at double digit growth rates - several of which are expected to be exited in the near term.

Another top-performing investment over the first quarter of 2024 was DiversiTech, a manufacturer of components and supplies for the US residential heating, ventilation, and air conditioning market. It was written up, mainly reflecting its financial performance and an increased valuation multiple. DiversiTech's financial performance has benefited from lower raw material and freight costs, alongside productivity gains from automation, which have partly offset discounting by competitors in some product categories.

Over the reporting month, Partners Group completed the previously announced acquisitions of ROSEN Group, a global provider of recurring, regulatory-driven inspection services for energy infrastructure assets, and Velvet CARE, one of the leading European manufacturers of hygiene paper products. Both transactions were closed at compelling entry valuations. In addition, the Fund transacted on two high-quality inflection portfolios on the secondary market providing the potential for long-term gains:

- Project Portrush 2.0 involved Partners Group's acquisition of LP interests in twelve buyout funds with an average vintage of 2018, at a high single-digit discount to NAV. The majority of the funds are US and Europe focused, with a portfolio of 265 underlying assets, well diversified across industry sectors.
- Project Toucan Two comprised Partners Group's proprietary acquisition of LP interests in two buyout funds, PAI VII and Carlyle Europe V, at an approximately 14% discount to NAV. The funds are invested in a broadly diversified portfolio of 37 companies in the resilient industrial and consumer sectors.

Partners Group was well-positioned for both transactions, given its existing investments in the funds and strong relationship with the managers. This allowed for comprehensive insights during diligence and bidding. Partners Group finds these investments attractive, given the meaningful upside potential of the inflection assets and the longstanding performance track records and value creation capabilities of the investment partners.

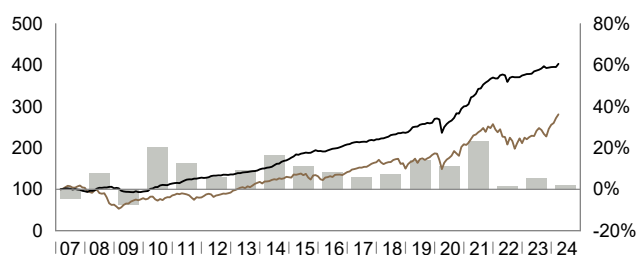

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Partners Group Global Value Fund is an Australian unit trust with the objective of achieving capital growth over the medium- and long-term by investing in private equity. It provides investors with a broad diversification across geographies, financing stages and investment types, while using Partners Group's relative value investment approach to systematically overweight those segments and investment types that offer attractive value at a given point in time, in order to significantly enhance risk-adjusted returns. The Fund allows investors to subscribe and redeem shares on a monthly basis, thus avoiding the long lock-up periods common in most private equity funds. The Fund may hedge certain currency exposure to reduce the risk of foreign exchange movements. The Fund is a feeder fund that invests in Partners Group Global Value SICAV ("Underlying Fund"). The Fund will invest in an AUD denominated share class of the Underlying Fund.

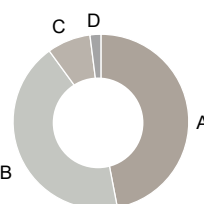

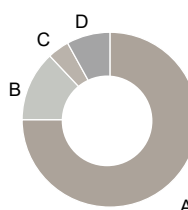

Investments by regional focus



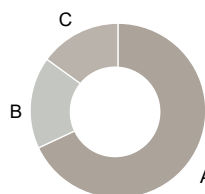
